

**Mar. 25 - Scripture:** Luke 19: 28-48

*Observation:* The Triumphal Entry - Our Lord knows now, just as he has known since the very beginning of time, each and every aspect of our lives. At the time of his triumphal entry, he could tell his disciples to go and get the colt, a perfect, young, never ridden colt. And he knew what the disciples should say to those asking about their actions well before the scene played out: "Because the Lord needs it." At the same time, he could predict and see their hearts and minds and voices praising him for the miracles they had seen. Likewise, today he sees us as we give praise for our own private miracles, delivered to us by His own hands. He knew that his disciples were blind at that time, but that soon that they would see. Likewise, he knows about our similar blindness today and helps remove the scales from our eyes, just as he knows our hearts and helps us PRAISE HIM.

*Application:* I will walk with perfect knowledge that my Lord knows me and has planned my steps for me.

*Prayer:* Lord, help us all to rely on you more. To ask for your guidance in all things and for willingness for you to order our steps. Lord, help us hear your instructions about our own personal "young colts". Help us to hear you and do your will.
