

Mar. 29 - Scripture: Luke 21: 20-38

A verse that speaks to you: Verse 25 is particularly compelling as it begins " There will be signs..."

Observation: This whole section of scripture is a very serious warning of how things in our world will get much worse before the true Kingdom of God is established by Christ when He comes again.

Application: I must remind myself daily that I live in a fallen, imperfect world spoiled by sin. I must constantly remember to give the grace to others in this fallen place just as I have received grace. I am also made aware that in this imperfect world the Good News of the better world to come is so important to share. This passage reminds me how serious this task is, and also that there are indeed signs of what Jesus spoke all around us. We must not procrastinate, but act boldly.

Prayer: Lord, help me to read the signs of the times You have provided for your followers. Lead me into wisdom through Your Spirit so that I can serve and glorify You in these troubling times. Amen.
