

Feb. 28 - Scripture: Luke 7: 1-26

A verse that speaks to you: 7: 9 - When Jesus heard this, he was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found such great faith even in Israel."

Observation: How often do we find Jesus amazed? Answer: just here. It's nice that Jesus, son of God, can be amazed. Look at what amazes him: a person's faith. A Gentile's faith on top of that. It's a faith that understands Jesus' authority. "You, Jesus, have a kingdom's might behind you and I respect this."

Application: In the ups and downs of life, I often do not look at Jesus and his authority. If I did, that faith would comfort me. And be in charge of me. I want to apply this in my life to the times I face when it feels like things are unraveling.

Prayer: Lord, may I see what this centurion saw and trust your kingdom authority. May this happen for me today. In Jesus' name.
